Foreword by Translator and editor

This book series **The Purpose Of Earthly Life** is mainly translations of Greek texts produced by The Spiritualist Society of Athens (Greece) "The Divine Light". The texts are transcripts of important teachings delivered by spirits between 1960 and 1979 through a medium (Mr Georgios Pizanis) to gatherings of this Spiritualist Society of Athens (Greece) "The Divine Light". The medium received the spiritual communications under the guidance and protection of Heaven. A number of Leaders and Teachers of the spiritual world delivered a large number of teachings, some of which are included here. The content of the books published in Greek is given mostly in the chronological order that the teachings were received.

The first book of this series entitled **What We Should Know Before We Depart Earth** covers topics which include the structure of Heaven, the creation and interaction of the heavenly entities, the roles of the soul, the spirit and the material body, death, euthanasia and suicide and the importance of balance in life.

In this second book I have selected 5 topics and then chosen the appropriate sections from the original Greek texts, to form chapters. Under each chapter subsection heading, I have provided the book number of the original text, the page number and the name of the communicating spirit(s). *e.g. [3-134] Pharah means book 3 in the bibliography, page 134 and Pharah is the spirit communicating via the medium.*

Each page in the book is divided into two sections. The wider one contains the translation and the margin contains remarks, biographies of the last incarnation of the communicating spirit or references that you may find useful. It also provides an area for you to pencil in your own comments and queries. For my benefit and for yours I have created a glossary of terms that may assist you with your reading.

The bibliography lists all the texts used in this book and others, using a sequential numbering system. The books may be purchased directly from The Spiritualist Society of Athens (Greece) web site (<http://www.theion-fos.com/>). If you are looking for a book on

spiritualism and more information on the subject of the first book in this series, I suggest: [15] **Spiritualism & Human Evolution** by Dimitrios Makrygiannis also from this website.

The language of the original Greek texts is difficult. Nowadays it is neither taught in schools nor is it commonly used. I was fortunate to finish my High School in Athens under the shadow of the Acropolis and was taught this particular version of the Greek language. Nevertheless, I trust that my translation is correct and that the deep and very important messages are not lost. This is my own interpretation of the texts.

The books are not easy to read as they introduce a number of subjects and concepts that may be unfamiliar to you. As with the first book my suggestion is that you read the book at least once cover to cover to get a broad understanding and then read it again carefully. There are a number of topics that will create debate. Please cross-reference them with the scriptures and Book One of this series. Seek and I am sure you will find.

My introduction to the original Greek texts and special spiritual communications were arranged by Ms Popi Tsoutsoura and Ms Kallipso Bistis both of whom encouraged me to translate the books. May the Lord give them the peace they have earned.

Preface

Have you ever wondered:

- How can I find Faith?
- Do we need pain to understand Love?
- Is logic the key to Truth?
- Is earthly Justice just?
- Is symbolism an ethical or non-ethical representation of an idea?

This second book of spiritual teachings translated from original transcripts of special communications delivered and written in Greek, continues I hope, to stimulate and provide us with some insight into the answers to these and no doubt many other questions. For this book I have selected five topics from the wide range of teachings communicated to us. Why these in particular you may ask.

It is my understanding that Faith, Love, Truth and Justice are the cornerstone of those lessons that we need to comprehend fully before we depart this earth for the last time and, The Cross as a symbol throughout the ages, is a fascinating representation of much of what is talked and written about.

For those of you who have not read the first book of the series, The Purpose of earthly Life, I recommend that you do so as it will give you a greater depth of understanding of much of what is contained here. You can download it free from www.divinepharos.org. The following four paragraphs summarize some of what is written in the first book. I trust it will assist you.

The Universe was dark and nothing existed. But within this non-existence there was The Creative Source that remains unknown to us. This Source that we call God had no form but had voice and created everything by His command. This way non-existence was converted to the worlds which now exist. During the period of non-existence the Heavenly Laws were created.

All souls were created with the same level of soul strength. At first the souls did not understand their relationship with God and so He gave them a spirit to enable them to perceive everything and to judge for themselves with free will. They became psycho-spiritual entities. A small number of these psycho-spiritual entities further developed their soul strength while in The Heavenly Paradise and remained there obedient to Him. They did not descend to Earth but became Angels and Archangels. The other rebellious psycho-spiritual entities that preferred to listen to and follow the Evil spirit were sent to the newly created Earth. The rebellious psycho-spiritual entities were not sent all together but in groups to different parts of Earth. Adam and Eve symbolize the beginning and represent groups of entities not just two individuals.

Man, that is the human entity, consists of three parts: matter (physical body), soul (psyche) and spirit (pnevma). The soul and spirit referred to as the psycho-spiritual entity is immortal. The soul and spirit are two individual entities that are eternally inseparable. They enter the physical body at birth and leave it at death whereupon the physical body decays and the psycho-spiritual entity continues its existence, returning to Heaven. When it reincarnates, it enters a new human body of the same gender.

God in His wisdom created Earth as a practical workshop where incarnated psycho-spiritual entities are perfected. God created Man last as an unpolished diamond. The polishing was to take place in the earthly workshop between Good and Evil. Man was the last creation on Earth so that he would find everything necessary for his sustenance and evolution.

According to illuminations from Heaven, Man is to live life according to two precepts: “everything in moderation” and “know thyself”. He should conduct his life in moderation, that is the harmonious balance between the two opposing elements of Good and Evil i.e. within a measure. The measure is the basis of human life and is the love of balance – it controls passions and determines the just. Poetry without measure does not have harmony and music without measure is a cacophony.

Know thyself is a maxim because we humans will never be able to completely know ourselves. This is a very difficult concept. But if we

make a continuous and intensive effort to understand it, then automatically we acquire the meaning of “know thyself”.

What is symbolism?

For the Babylonians, Assyrians, Incas and many other civilizations unknown to us, the cross was the symbol of Divinity that governed everything. The people of those times never imagined that the Cross would materialize. The human body in an upright position with the arms extended horizontally forms a cross. Do not think that the Cross was used as a Holy Symbol only from the Lord’s time on Earth. From ancient times the Cross symbolized God and Man; the link between God and Man being the soul. The majesty of the Cross is unsurpassed.

The symbol has a stronger impact than the idea that it represents and through symbolism, ideas are regenerated, the virtuous ones being the result of Heavenly Values. Therefore, a symbol is neither good nor evil. It adapts to an idea and takes on its characteristics. Symbolism can be an ethical or a non-ethical representation of an idea.

Will Faith help my understanding of all this?

Ideological research sharpens the intellect by studying the spirit thoroughly. When found within a framework of Faith, this widens the light of knowledge and foresees whatever applied science cannot foresee. Applied practical science requires proof, until this proof is made unnecessary by science itself.

Instead of wondering about the meaning of Faith it is best to clear your conscience from the burdens of your spirit because it is your spirit that hinders you and persuades you into courses of actions that you would not take if you were in a tranquil state of mind. Faith can be cultivated when the conditions are right.

Faith is acquired through your own strength. Just think, is it possible for a non-swimmer to swim well? No, he has to train. Faith is like the sea. By training, you learn to swim in its deep waters. However don’t try too hard and become overly religious as this can have the opposite effect.

Pain essentially does not exist when you have Faith, because you realize that everything has a purpose and with this realization comes the understanding that everything is moving towards God and the Heavenly Kingdom. Pain is the means by which we perceive Love therefore do not avoid it as though it is something harmful to you. It must be endured with optimism and with the hope that it will cure you from the real death that takes place in Heaven.

God is not an egoist! Do you believe that He commands every one of us to love Him? He does but He does not do this for Himself. What He is asking is that we, His Rays, the human entities, are loved because when Man truly loves God, it is impossible for him not to love his neighbour and so we receive this love. True love connects the soul with the Spiritual World and is so pure that it does not allow Evil to interfere.

Truth together with Justice is the highest virtue of the soul. Tendencies towards Love, Truth and Justice lead us to the road of Virtue and minimize our spiritual burden. We must not forget that the light of Truth is blinding and that its intensity may be altered by accurate and logical words. However all who have advanced knowledge talk about logic and consider it as the key to the Truth but they are deceived. Aristotle stated in his communications from Heaven that there can be white logic and dark logic and while the word "logic" does not encompass the Truth, Truth encompasses logic!

As said before, Justice together with Truth is the highest virtue of the soul. The Law of Justice is the Unwritten Law. However neither the human laws nor those who administer them are worthy to speak of ethics and Justice. God's commandments, dictated to Moses through spiritual communication, formed the basis of earthly laws. Jesus came to complete Moses commandments.

We are told that our laws are very material and need to be more spiritual.

"The Holy Spirit states, "There is no religion higher than Truth and that Truth can be found wherever God is. Truth together with Justice is the highest virtue of the soul".

See here, why at the directive of My Father I opened a New Path to directly teach the world of destruction, betrayal and waste. This path is called "The Path of Heavenly Logos". It is pure in all aspects. No unclean spirit can enter it. The Leaders of My Heavenly Kingdom have the freedom to talk through it to Man. Others may with My permission.

Everything is examined and those who do not believe that a Source of the Spiritual World on Earth exists, will hear My Voice and echo. You are free to discover where the Light of Truth resides.
